
Notes: The site has been mined out and screening equipment has been removed. Vegetation is dense throughout the property with ≈ 20 foot berms surrounding it. A large stockpile of crushed concrete product remains at the east end of the site and a front-end loader was operating at the time of inspection. There are several sediment traps onsite that were stabilized and holding water. The permittee reported "No Discharge" for this quarter. There is an unnamed tributary of the Paint Branch that runs through the site and is being maintained. Additional reclamation is required before release including grading and waste, equipment, and stockpile removal. The permittee plans to develop the site and hearings are being held by Montgomery County.
